Dear Parents/Carers of Year 10 students,

Year 10 subject consultation evening (online) - Tuesday 2nd December, 4:30pm to 7:30pm

We will be holding our Year 10 Subject Consultation Evening on 2nd December, where you will be given the opportunity to meet with your child's subject teachers to discuss how they are progressing with their studies. The evening will be hosted on "SchoolCloud" software and this letter will outline how the system works.

Video Appointments – how do I book?

The booking system will be the same as the normal subject consultation evening system. Appointments can be booked online **from 7pm today** by visiting <https://clevedonschool.schoolcloud.co.uk> and following the log-in prompts.

If you are unable to do this, please contact your child's class teachers, who will book the appointment for you. You will receive confirmation of your booking(s) via email.

Additionally, teachers may book appointments when there is a need to see you to celebrate success or work together on a way forward to improve the learning outcomes.

Video appointments – what do I need?

In order to make video calls, you need as a minimum, the following software:

- a device with a microphone and speaker/headphones
- a compatible up-to-date web browser:

iPhone/iPad: Safari Note: there is a known issue joining video calls using iOS 14.2. Please upgrade any iOS 14.2 devices to iOS 14.3 or use an alternate device.

Android: Chrome or Firefox

Windows: Chrome, Firefox or Microsoft Edge

Mac: Safari, Chrome or Firefox

Linux: Chrome or Firefox

Suggested hardware:

- Front-facing camera on a smart phone, laptop or computer with a webcam.
- You may get better audio quality by using a headset (or earphones with a microphone) or having a small plug-in speaker

If technology is a barrier to participating in the evening, please speak with your Head of House.

Aim of the meeting

As with normal consultation evenings, the appointments are an opportunity to discuss the progress that your child has been making in their lessons, as well as to learn about their areas for development.

With a 5-minute time slot (the appointments automatically sign you out) it is important that the meeting is focused. Staff will explain the areas that students are working well on and will importantly outline the areas

that need to be developed further. By the end of the meeting, you should be aware of the progress made thus far and the necessary steps needed to secure success in the future as well as the role you can play in helping achieve this.

When there is a need for further discussion, staff may ask that the discussion is continued either by phone or email, as there is no option available to extend the meeting slot. Should you be unable to make the consultation evening, please feel free to contact your child's teacher in order to discuss their progress.

I hope that you find the meetings with our staff productive and that you are able to celebrate the successes already achieved and identify the next steps for your child.
