Dear Clevedon School Families,

Further to my recent newsletter and as a bit of a whoops on my part, I do need to clarify my expectations on blazers in the hot weather.

Students do need to ensure that they have their blazers with them in school. Blazers remain a compulsory part of the uniform and as a default, worn at all times, including morning assemblies.

However, in the warmer weather (typically but not exclusively in Term 6), students can self-regulate the wearing of them in classrooms, breaktime and lunchtime. I appreciate 'self-regulation' is a slightly subjective term, but it allows students to be in control of their own temperature management!

As a reminder, shirts and ties should always be worn smartly and in accordance with our expectations: shirts tucked in and top buttons and ties done up to an appropriate length.

School jumpers remain optional and are not worn in lieu of a school blazer ie it is not an either or.
